



Breckenridge Recreation Center Summer Camp Guidelines

Welcome to Summer 2020 at the Breckenridge Rec Center (BRC). We are excited to see you and glad you chose BRC for your summer camp activities!

In light of COVID 19 the BRC is taking a few extra precautions we would like you to be aware of before your first day of camp.

Summit County Health Department has requested the following guidelines for all persons living, working and recreating in Summit County

- Maintain 6 ft of physical distance
- Wash hands often
- Wear a face covering
- Stay home when sick
- Get tested immediately if symptoms occur

With those guidelines already in place, the BRC has put together the following guidelines for all staff and participants to follow while attending all summer camps.

- Take temperatures daily. If your child has any symptoms or has a temperature of 100.4, please keep them home
- Each camper is to wear a face covering. If your child does not adhere to this guideline, they will not be allowed to attend camp
- Practice social distancing. Each child will receive a basket for their belongings each day. All personal belongings must be CLEARLY LABELED

- Disinfecting will happen throughout the day as children transitions through activities
- Temperatures will be taken throughout the day. If at any time your child is showing symptoms or a temperature above 100.4 the parent will be notified and will have 1 hour to pick up their child. The child will then not be allowed to return to camp until 24 hrs after they are symptom free.

Cancellation Policy

All cancellations are subject to a \$3.00 charge unless the Breckenridge Recreation Center cancels the program. Then a full refund will be awarded.
